  - b. You had physical evidence \_\_\_\_ or did not have physical evidence \_\_\_\_ that the tumor(s) was/were growing?
  - c. You had definite evidence the cancer had spread throughout the body because of exploratory surgery to possibly remove the larger tumor(s), when the doctor cut you open in June 2004, saw that the cancer, had spread throughout the stomach area, and immediately closed you back up without removing any tumor?

However, if I am incorrect in remembering any of the above and you are not sure the Magnaphase increased the cancer, would it be worth doing 1 treatment with the Magnaphase and compare blood smear to the AZ-58 results?

Hit another blip with the bowel wanting to obstruct so have been dealing with that.

It is settling down and I will get back to the slide making. Just had to deal with this crises first.

The RTI 1 group 15 15 gives me the best effect that I have found so far but I need to use it a few more times before I could say a sure thing.

Next CA125 is still a few weeks out, maybe 4 I think or 3 more.

Magnaphase made me nutty in the head. I hated that machine. It messed with my brain and it was at that time the immune system just seemed so shot and would not come back at all. The friend you had that is a genetics? specialist said that maybe that machine damaged my DNA and we were worried about that also.

It did not kill my cancer nor did it help to hold it. Yes when they opened me the cancer was all over the abdomen (not the stomach which is just the food pouch). It was on my bowel, in my liver, in my vaginal stump and the left bowel area had that big mass just like the vagina did. Personnaly I would never use that machine again. For me it frightened me and I just could not deal with the effect it had on my eyes and brain. The ONLY machine that we ever had diagnostic lab and scan confirmation that cancer cells died was your very first machine. That is it. all the others probably helped hold it down or slow it but the truth is that I have had cancer continue to grow all the way through other than that first machine. I am still not sure with this machine. It seems to quiet it for 1 to 2 days and then I need to get right back on it again. The CA 125 so far is not confirming die off, as it has shot through the roof. I don't think we can explain it just yet.

I do think this Ambrotose has been an incredible glyconutritonal supplement and maybe that with the machine just might be the right combination. I had RBC and hematacrit and Hemoglobin blood tests of the red blood cells (RBC) that were SOOO Good Friday that they held my procrit shot. That is a first ever for me. And the platelets bounced back in 3.5 weeks to 103,000 and last Friday they were 113,000. I had not done that in a very, very long time. The WBC (white cells) report was not back yet when I was sent home. The week before it was at 3900 and I typically was 1700-2900 and that would be about all it would do even with Neulasta. So something is definitely going on in the immunes system. I had 3 really good days last week. And the last two OK just not quiet as perky. I had done the light and I also increased my Ambrotose dose. I still have 9 tablespoons to increase it up to /day to get the the dose they were seeing cancer reversing to normal cells. It gives you a lot of detoxing side effects. So I had headaches these past two days and then this bowel blip. So consumed by that. Last bowel episode was jan 1st so at least I am getting some time between them. They do wipe you out and consume my time.

Seems I was using the Magna phase for the duration of the cycles till the timer went off. I think that was 20 minutes. If the tumor was still active I would repeat it but not always plus I was still working and it was hard to get every thing done. But 20 minutes is probably the accurate time. There WAS physical evidence that the tumors grew. The abdomen continued have new cancer sites and I had cancer all over, likes grains of sand in the abdomen. It did not stop it at all and I doubt if there was any kill or die off.

Even though you little light that you used for kathy didn't kill cancer either, that one was much easier to deal with and did not make me nutty upstairs. I just wished it had worked but it did not.

As I said before I would not do the Magnaphase light ever again. It was not good for me and it did something to my immune system that it took me a long time to get it back in normal range. that fall Oct-Dec I juiced heavily and that was what finally got my liver tests back to normal. Even at that time I was still having difficulty with the WBC and RBCs. Eventually I used the injections I had left over for the WBC boosting (neupogen) and that kicked the WBC up. But I have had to boost with neulasta (replacement med) to keep the WBCs up and now it looks like this ambrotose is doing something positively and exciting.

Jim my gut instinct is that people will die if they use the magnaphase. Most are not as in tured to the body as I am and most will not be that aggressive nor will they tell you. It is your decison but I am being honest here and think your AZ58 is the better way. Look at your portable light one combined with AMbrotose or something like

Look at your portable light one combined with Ambrotose or something like that. That one did not seem to damage my body even when I used it 2 and 3 times in one day. It just did not kill the cancer. Could that one be boosted a bit (to this 2.5 volt range) and keep the gating and get them on Ambrotose. Just a thought.

Let me know if I didn't answer all that you needed. Bottom line I think the higher volt, AZ58, gating are all critical in this equation. We will know in a few weeks with my CA125. If we are getting kill off, I am just not sure how long it will take to get the CA125 down as I have so much cancer in there. I honestly don't know. So we may still have high lab values in a few weeks. My niece said 2 to 3 months to clear if I am truly getting into a healing crisis. I feel good and I think that is an important piece of data and probably more accurate than the CA125. If we look at the lab value alone, then the AZ58 is not having the effect we want also as of yet. I still think we are making progress and just need to wait it out.

That is exactly what I needed to know. We will never use the Magnaphase again. I had remembered a couple months back where you seemed to question whether you had given some older trials a fair assessment, but you had never said which. Now I know for absolute sure, you weren't thinking of the Magnaphase when you said that.

I do have the original AZ-58 back, but it was damaged in shipment. Madie's ex just threw it in a box without proper packaging. However, I am sure I could get it working again, if needed. Let's see where you're at with the next CA125 first.

Based on what you are saying, I will go back to the portable completely solid state design and see if I can duplicate what we are doing with the AZ-58 semi-solid state unit now, just as you suggest.
